TEST COMMENTS: Planted in twin rows spaced 8" apart on 30" centers. The twin 8" planted sites have very uniformly spaced seeds resulting in excellent spacing for healthy harvestable plants. Plants being spaced 3" to 4" apart, have more room, thus exhibit additional lower branching. Lat: N40.4451, Long: W87.60923
