TEST COMMENTS:

This trial was planted during and into ideal conditions. The soybeans emerged strong and quickly out of the gate, and never looked back. Moisture appeared not to be a limiting factor, as there was above-average rainfall in June and July. High water tables, with proximity to the Missouri River, may have helped offset the more limited August rainfall. Harvest was efficient with no green stem and perfect seed moisture levels. The plants' internodes were especially close.

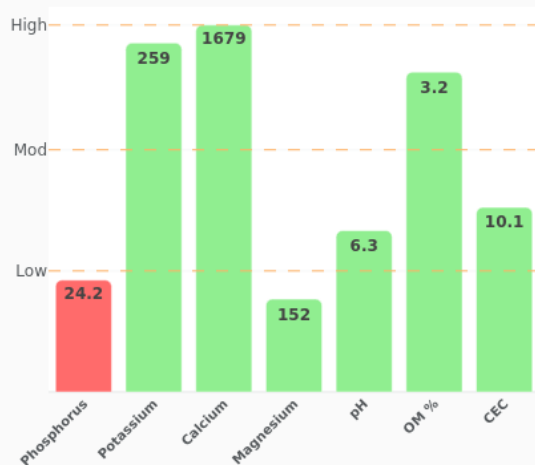

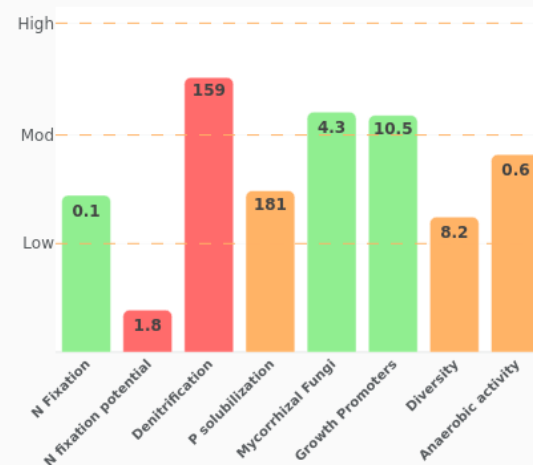

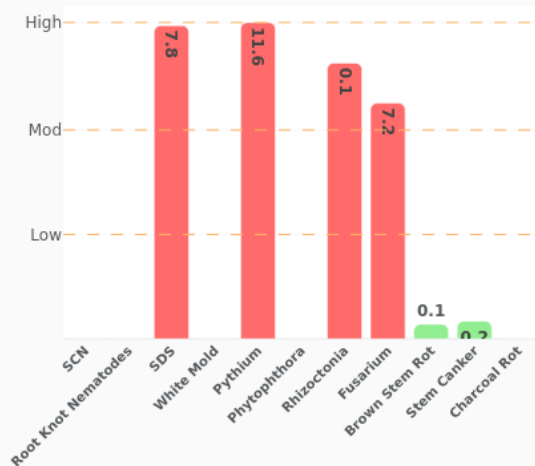

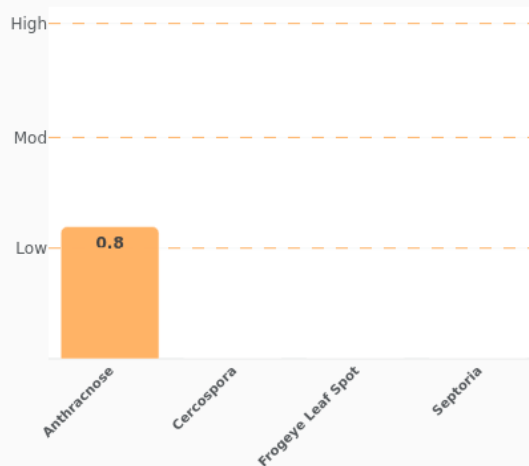
