TEST COMMENTS:

The seed planted well in this no-till site. The site was planted on the shallow side of the spectrum due to slightly heavy soils. Soon after plants emerged, deer damage was observed. This occurred in isolated pockets throughout the trial. The accumulated recorded rainfall stayed above the 10-year average. This was a clean and uniform site.

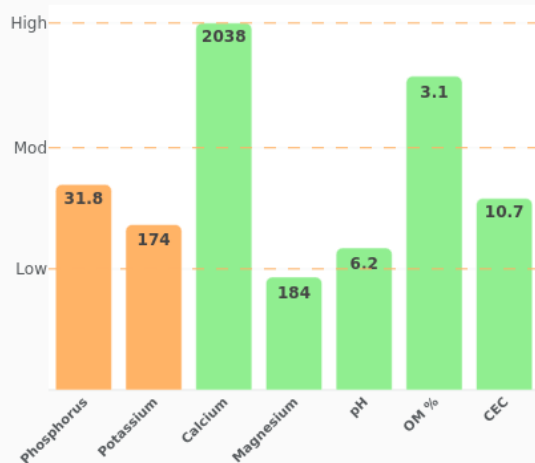

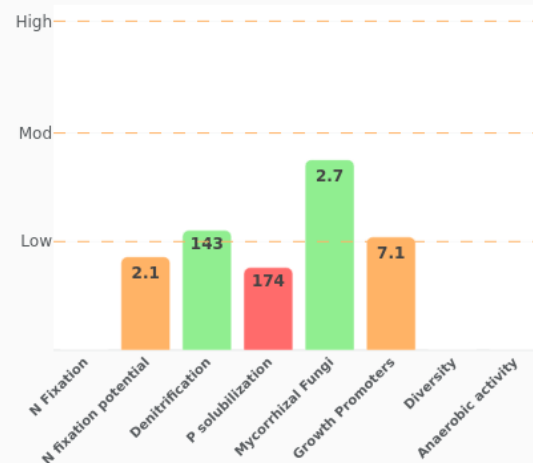

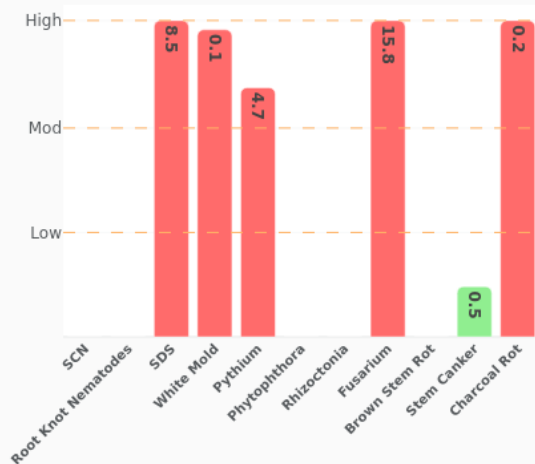

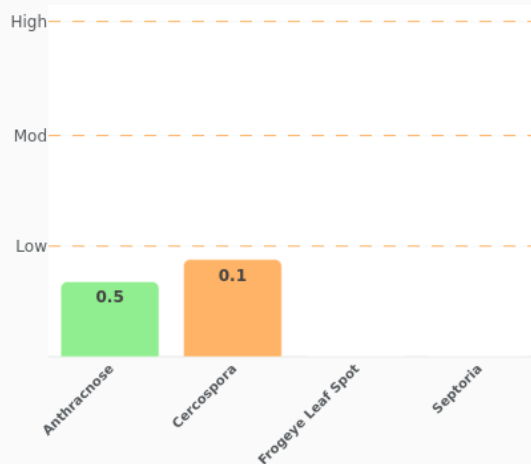
